## Athletic Emergency Action Plan

### Practice (Football)

2018 – 19

**CODE RED** is the call to action made by any coach during practice when a player has sustained a serious and/or life threatening injury. When a coach yells, “Code Red” all activities immediately cease and the following plan is to be enacted:

- 1) **UWA** (Trainer) will immediately examine the player to determine his need and our next course of action. **TRAINER IS IN CHARGE.**
- 2) **Coach Levy** will *immediately call for ambulance and rescue squad.* **UWA (trainer)** or **Coach Felder** will make the phone call. If you don't have yours, **Coach Levy** will be with **Trainer** and relay any necessary information to the rescue squad in route. He will then *directly assist Trainer with the injured player.*
- 3) **Coach Harris** will *immediately gather all players in an area away from the injured player.* Players will take a knee and await further instructions on where to go.
- 4) **Coach Mitchell** will *immediately acquire vehicle for transportation of player* if for any reason ambulance is not available and transport is necessary. This will be determined by **Trainer.**
- 5) **Coach Williams** will *secure medical records.* Records will be stored in the equipment hut on the practice field and in the field house. *Relay any information to Trainer which may affect treatment* (i.e. allergy, diabetes, prior injury, etc.). **Coach Williams** will have records available for rescue squad or give to **Coach Mitchell** if player has to be transported by our travel team.
- 6) **Coach Harris** will *secure a clear path for entry and exit of any emergency vehicle(s).* This may include clearing parents/spectators or having equipment moved. **Coach Harris** will be visible at entry point and direct emergency vehicle(s) in.

- 4) **Coach Levy** will *immediately acquire vehicle for transportation of player* if for any reason ambulance is not available and transport is necessary. This will be determined by **Trainer.**
- 5) **Coach Williams** will *secure medical records.* Records will be stored in the equipment hut on the practice field and in the field house. *Relay any information to Trainer which may affect treatment* (i.e. allergy, diabetes, prior injury, etc.). **Coach Williams** will have records available for rescue squad or give to **Coach Levy** if player has to be transported by our travel team.
- 6) **Coach Mitchell** will *secure a clear path for entry and exit of any emergency vehicle(s).* This may include clearing parents/spectators or having equipment moved. **Coach Mitchell** will be visible at entry point and direct emergency vehicle(s) in.
- 7) Away Procedure – **Trainer** (and **Coach Levy** if necessary) will accompany injured player. **Coach Mitchell** will contact parent/guardian to have insurance information ready. **Coach Felder** will address team as needed and help follow away procedures. The remainder of the staff will secure the team's departure, equipment, and facilities under the direction of **Coach Harris.**
