- 4) <u>Coach Mitchell</u> will *immediately acquire vehicle for transportation of player* if for any reason ambulance is not available and transport is necessary. This will be determined by **Trainer.**
- 5) <u>Coach Williams</u> will secure medical records. Records will be stored in the equipment hut on the practice field and in the field house. Relay any information to Trainer which may affect treatment (i.e. allergy, diabetes, prior injury, etc.).
