The NATA Foundation Board of Directors would like to thank each individual and corporate donor for contributions made to the organization in 2011. Due to their generosity, the NATA Foundation was able to support the many programs and projects detailed in this report, which benefit each and every athletic trainer by advancing the mission of the profession through research and education.

### **Research Programs**

- Five Master's Grants were awarded in 2011, totaling \$4,914
- Three General Grants were awarded in 2011, totaling \$239,299
- From the NATA Foundation's inception in 1991 to December 31, 2011, the organization has awarded 215 grants totaling more than \$3.1 million
- Approximately 255 Free Communications Oral and Poster presentations were given at the NATA Annual Meeting in New Orleans
- 14 NATA Foundation grant recipients presented their findings to the NATA membership in New Orleans
- Abstracts of original research were published in the *Supplement to the Journal of Athletic Training*, which was made available to NATA members
- The Doctoral Dissertation Award was presented to Jason Peter Mihalik, PhD, CAT(C), ATC in honor of David H. Perrin, PhD, ATC, FNATA
- The New Investigator Award was presented to Steven P. Broglio, PhD, ATC
- The Medal for Distinguished Athletic Training Research was presented to Jay Hertel, PhD, ATC, FNATA
- Outcomes Research Grant continued funding

### **Education Programs**

- 61 graduate and undergraduate scholarships, totaling \$140,300, were awarded in 2011
- Presentation of annual Lecture Exchange Program with the AMSSM, AOSSM and ACSM continued in 2011

### **Capital Campaign**

- The goal of the Capital Campaign was to generate a significant portion of the annual resources needed to continue advancing the profession from interest generated by the NATA Foundation's endowments
- Although the Capital Campaign is officially complete, volunteers and staff continue to work diligently to raise funds for the 34 endowments established as part of the campaign
- Eleven of the endowments have been completed, eight are fully pledged and fifteen are still in progress
